There have also been great advances in DIY technology for artists that help facilitate the scene's contributions to a global increase in tolerance for diversity, social consciousness, social justice, etc. It's great to see social networking at it's best. The underground has come a long way in recent years.

**Q. Are there any radical projects active now that inspire y'all?**

The preservation and advancement of indigenous culture in the Americas is one thing that inspires us. There are a lot of movements of restoration of languages, culture, diet, music, art, and ultimately land back.

Locally, The Charleston in Bremerton is one of the most invigorating projects as it brings together many different subcultures and provides a safe and open-minded environment for a healthy and diverse scene to grow.

**Q. What were some of your musical inspirations, punk or otherwise?**

Some of our main influences have been: John Trudell, Doom, Discharge, Ministry, and Napalm Death, among many others.

**Q. How do you see the deeply spiritual tones in your music connecting with the political nature of your lyrics?**

Unfortunately, the word spirituality was hijacked by religions. When you say spirituality, most people think of organized religions. For us, spirituality means to be connected with our environment, the universe, the elements (air, earth, fire and water), and each other. Spirituality for us, is understanding the cycles of the sun, the moon, and the stars in relation to our own lives.
