Q. West Seattle was even harder to reach during the bridge closures; did that shape your outreach style and how has it changed since reopening?

We started during the bridge closure and because of that, we decided to be hyperlocal - if you don't have a connection in or to West Seattle (living here, family here so out here often, working out here and spending life out this way), you can support us in other ways than being involved with distro and logistics. It's still been core to us since the reopening.

Q. We hear y'all have worked hard at making your organizing accessible, sustainable, and anti-ableist, what advice would you have for others?

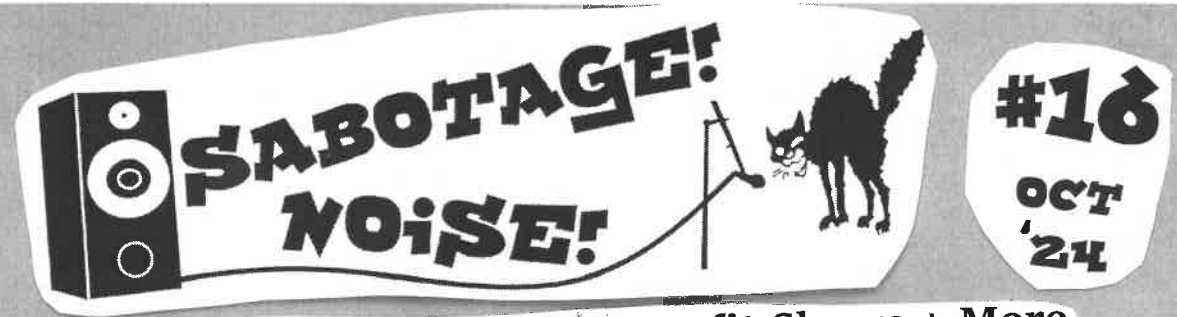
Listen to us when we say sick and disabled people can do shit, at our own pace and ability in our own ways. We prioritize each other's health and safety and have scaled back as needed and don't pressure folks to do more than they want. Being sustainable in pacing and supporting each other requires learning from and being in relationship to sick and disabled people. We make it clear that people should take breaks when they want to. We ask for help and try to provide it to each other.

WEST SEATTLE MUTUAL AID PARTY

West Seattle Mutual Aid Party has been holding it down supporting homeless neighbors in more in an often overlooked part of the city. **Sabotage Noise** presents a short interview with some of their members.

Q. What's a typical day or week look like for your crew?

Most of the week is talking or doing logistics, and a lot of it. We have logistics meetings, various supply runs and coordinate on Signal for reupping of supplies that need to be ordered online. We do distro on Saturday, which takes about three hours, with two routes.

Q. What unique challenges do y'all face organizing in West Seattle, so far from many other mutual aid groups operating in Downtown or Cap Hill?

There's hardly any services in this area, mobile support from the city is non-existent, and we have one small sad public needle disposal in the restroom of a park. As for what other crews are doing, we have connections with Long Haul Kitchen, Stop the Sweeps and a couple others because folks on our crew work with them too.
