Chess Club Interview cont.

The idea is to bounce around to various venues, exploring different neighborhoods in Seattle and creating unique experiences. This adds a bit of fun and adventure, plus allows us to connect and engage with different parts of the city. We also plan to host meetups at unconventional and surprising venues - (have you ever played chess in the woods?) So stay tuned for that.

Q. Do you see any lessons for anarchists in playing chess?

Well, at its core chess is just a game - like shooting a basketball in a hoop - but there are some lessons that anarchists can learn from the game. For instance, each piece moves differently and has different strengths and weaknesses, just like every person! Not every anarchist is made to be at the frontlines of the barricades, and not every anarchist is meant to read stacks of theory. The key is to find out what your strengths are and use them to help better the world and participate in the movement.

Q. Whats your favorite chess opening move? The wing-it and scramble.

Q. What other events are y'all putting on?

Last week we hosted the first ever Seattle Folk Punk Orchestra Hootenanny, which was a total blast. About 30 people showed up with guitars, banjos, accordions, and other acoustic instruments and created a make-shift folk punk band on the spot. It was pretty amazing - we'll likely do that again.

Chess will always be the cornerstone of the club, but we absolutely plan to do other creative events and projects as the ideas sprout organically. The purpose of the Seattle Anarchist Chess Club is to have a good time and in the spirit of anarchist tradition be spontaneous fresh and outside the box. We will blow where the wind takes us.

Q. Any advice for anarchists looking to start chess or other hobby-related clubs?

Do go for it and don't be afraid to fail. Do put effort into planning and don't be flaky or unreliable. Do trust your instincts and don't be reluctant to ask for help. And if it doesn't pan out, go home and pet your dog.

Like toppling kings? Sabotage Noise presents a short interview with the new Seattle Anarchist Chess Club!

Q. What inspired you to start a chess club for anarchists?

The main inspiration came from a desire to create a relaxed and chill space for anarchists, allies, and neighbors in Seattle. Many anarchist projects tend to focus on serious political work, which is critically important. We felt there was a need to establish something a bit lighter - a welcoming environment for people to gather, play some chess, and enjoy each other's company without the weight of social pressures or expectations.

We wanted to carve out space in the city that is openly and forwardly for anarchists, but also sincerely welcoming to all who want to join in and hangout. Fun and recreation are an essential part of life too, especially for anarchists! The intention is to build community and have friendly and nice moments for all us earth humans.

Q. How has a typical chess night gone?

So far so good! Typically 15 to 25 people attend each monthly chess club meetup, and there have been many dramatic games. Everyone is invited, regardless of skill level. You just show up, folks are very welcoming and it's easy to find a game or just kick it. Normally we are at a cafe or collective and people are encouraged to come even if they don't feel like playing chess.
