

CASA DEL XOLO INTERVIEW CONT.

What does your community work outside bakery hours look like?

- Casa del Xolo is a separate entity from the bakery, so everything we do as a collective is independent from the business, aside from sharing the same physical space and having some overlap in members. (L & H)

What sorts of struggles can a group wanting to maintain a space like this expect?

- Our biggest struggles have been generating funds and maintaining committed volunteers. Most of our income for Casa del Xolo comes from running live music events that are organized by the collective. We try to prioritize supporting artists so Casa del Xolo takes only a small cut from the profits and the rest goes to the performers. (L & H)

How do you keep Casa del Xolo/Lazy Cow a safe space for marginalized communities?

- As a collective, we approve acts every Wednesday during our open meetings. Many of our members are from the same marginalized communities we are trying to protect. (L)

Last but not least, how can people find out about or book events and follow your project?

- Folks who are interested in getting involved can fill out a volunteer form on our website and show up to our weekly meetings. Engaging with our community can also look like joining our open dinner gathering on Wednesdays or showing up to live music events that are posted about on our Instagram (@Casadelxolo). (H)

CASA DEL XOLO MUTUAL AID AND CULTURE IN FREMONT

Casa del Xolo is a mutual aid project based in Lazy Cow, a vegan bakery in the heart of Seattle's Fremont neighborhood. Casa del Xolo is a center for mutual aid, cultural expression, and community building for marginalized groups. The collective that is Casa del Xolo (CdX) hosts an on-site pantry, regular free-to-book shows, and projects like their "garage initiative" which canvasses the neighborhood to find people willing to open spare garages for emergency housing or storage.

Sabotage Noise asked Lara (L) and Hannah (H), a couple of Casa del Xolo members, a few questions about their work:

What's the origin behind CdX and Lazy Cow existing in one space?

- Mutual aid groups often have to acquiesce to the needs of wealthy donors or constantly fundraise. I conceived of Lazy Cow as a way to independently fund the mutual aid group, Casa del Xolo. (L)

Do you have any advice for someone wanting to start or sustain a similar space?

- If it's grueling effort, that means you're doing something right. (L)
