ing the cops, so we packed up and hauled ass back to the house to finish up our set! As we walked back some of us sang the line from Loose Lips by Kimya Dawson "we won't stop until somebody calls the cops, and even then we'll start again and just pretend that nothing ever happened!" It was dubbed Folk Punk Coachella.

Q: Seattle is a very difficult city to get a crowd moving and moshing and yall manage it with a banjo. Any advice for artists trying to melt that side of the Seattle Freeze?

In our experience, the Seattle Freeze only exists if you also feed into it, and people actually really want to dance and have a good time, they just need a little encouraging. So our goal is always to just not give them a choice, we start off by yelling at them and play fast and loud songs through our whole set. We also genuinely have such a fun time performing, and that gets people excited as well!

Q: Your flash mob starbucks roastery album release was a sick viral moment, do you have advice for artists trying to make a splash like that? We obviously knew that would get attention when we posted it, but the that idea was one we'd had for a long time just because we fucking hate starbucks and thought it would be funny. The stuff that resonates with people on the internet is usually the stuff where they can tell you're having a good time or doing something that makes you excited. Honestly our advice is don't try, just do cool and silly shit and have fun.

Q: What radical or mutual aid projects in Seattle inspire you?

We're both huge fans of PHRA and Stop the Sweeps. We were also super inspired by all the folks who worked so hard to try to save the BLM Memorial Garden in Cal Anderson, and the tree sitters who saved Luma the Cedar in Wedgwood.

Sister Wife Sex Strike A Q&A on Mosh Pits and Banjos

Sabotage Noise is thrilled to present our first interview with a band! We got together with Pigeon and Moth of Seattle folk punk band Sister Wife Sex Strike to ask them a few questions:

Q: Who are your biggest punk musical influences? How about other genres? Honestly I don't think either of us are super influenced by like standard punk. Pigeon is a huge folk punk fan, but mostly got into it because they grew up on country music, and Moth had never heard of folk punk before meeting Pigeon. I do think we're both super inspired by music that is not punk but has punk vibes without intending to. Moth is super inspired lyrically by Randy Newman's satirical critiques of religion, government, and other forms of power. Pigeon is inspired by folk music of all kinds, especially old time and klezmer - local folk punk klezmer band Brivele has been a huge inspiration to them. Within folk punk, we're both musically very inspired by Holy Locust.

Q: Whats the wildest story from a show y'all have played?

We played a house show in Lancaster, PA with our friends Local News Legend and Frog Legs that was absolutely packed to the gills before the first band even began. There was literally no room for anybody to move, especially not if they wanted to dance or mosh. So when it came time for our set, we decided we needed to move outside, so we trekked in the rain with over 100 punks to an abandoned parking garage a few blocks away where we played about 70% of our set before someone noticed a neighbor call-
